Proposal:

Add:

- 1. R1 for turbo/supercharged/high displacement cars (RA's Open, G5; NASA's 2wd/4wd Heavy)
 - a) AWD turbo cars in R1 must use a 34mm turbo restrictor
- 2. R2 for non-turbo cars (RA's Open Lite, G2; NASA's 2WD/4WD lite)
- 3. Rally Logbooked cars only-includes NASA Rally, RA, FIA, CARS. Any car that is not logbooked must be preapproved by the event Chair and/or Tech. Any car that does not have a current RA or NASA logbook SHOULD get approval from Tech before an event.
- 4. Do not need to be registered/street legal as there are no transits.
- 5. Driver and co-driver must have all safety gear as required by Logbook's sanctioning body
- 6. Times are cumulative over both days, each timed run being considered a special stage
- 7. Bogey times: If a run is missed (DNF/DNS), time will be 120% of the slowest car in that class for that run (or the previous run if all cars in class miss the same run). Maximum 2 "bogey" times per weekend
- 8. No Rally license required, SCCNH/KSCC/SCCV membership strongly encouraged
- 9. Driver and Co-driver points per class. Must meet NEHA minimum event limit to be eligible for year end points
- 10. Teams must finish all runs in a car meeting their class rules. It does not need to be the same car for all runs.
- 11. Tires: DOT tires or Tarmac Rally Tires. Slicks are disallowed: "slicks" are defined as any tire that does not have a minimum of 1.6mm (2/32") tread depth over at least a 17% void area.
- 12. Any rule not directly addressed by the rally class rules defaults to NEHA SP class rules. (example: all cars with a kill switch must have an air horn installed)
