

2010 Burke Mountain Hillclimb 2

The Killington Sports Car Club is proud to present the Burke 2 Hillclimb. August 27-29, 2010
General Information

This event is a time trial on the Burke Mountain Toll Road, on premises graciously provided by the State of Vermont, the Burke Mountain Corp., and the Town of Burke, Vermont.

This event will run according to the New England Hillclimb Series Regulations, Classifications, and Technical and Safety Requirements. Rally America will also be including all the NEHA hillclimb events in their schedule. Rally teams agree to abide by Rally America Rules for car prep and safety regulations. These and all NEHA events are open to generally all street cars and most race cars. Please see Regulations section of the www.hillclimb.org website for full details on regulations, classifications and technical and safety requirements.

Scoring for the regular hillclimb entrants will be based on their fastest time on Sunday (unless Sunday is rained out then Saturday times will be used.) Rally car team results will be based on cumulative times for all their runs from both days. We must additionally comply with the terms of the Club's Special Use Permit from the state, State Park regulations for Time Trials, and our agreements with Burke and the Town of Burke. Speedway Safety provides our professional rescue service.

ENTRY FEES: Members receive a \$10.00 discount. This includes members of KSCC, SCCNH, or SCCV. An early entry fee (postmarked by August 18) is \$150 for club members; \$160 for non-members, late entry is \$165 for club members; \$175 for non-members. Rally Car Team Fee \$170, late entry is \$185 (**these fees include your two day road fees.**) Entry is limited to the first 60 competitors.

LUNCH: All workers and drivers receive lunch each day. Lunch will be 45 minutes long beginning at approx. 12:00 noon.

MANDATORY ROOKIE ORIENTATION: if you have not run THIS HILL before, you must attend rookie instruction on Friday evening. See the Schedule for details. You will not need your car for this instruction session.

At this event, our goal is to use the time allotted to us by the state permit (8 AM to 5:30 PM) to the maximum extent possible, and minimize waiting time. Our schedule to achieve this includes an EARLY scheduling of Workers and Drivers meetings, and a 45 minute lunch turnaround.

We will use a split FAM (familiarization) run to minimize the possibility of incidents and provide a more effective FAM run for all competitors.

This is a muffled event, with a target of 90 dBa or less at 50 feet from exit of exhaust. ALL Vehicles must be teched in the campground. If your vehicle is not street legal and staying in mid-Burke lot, it must be trailered or towed to and from. Drivers are responsible for providing a jack in the campground tech. Staging of all vehicles for FAM and timed runs will occur in the campground for Saturday and Sunday. ALL DRIVERS MUST BE PRESENT AT SATURDAY AND SUNDAY DRIVERS' MEETING.

Burke Mountain Hillclimb

This hillclimb is a time-trial held on the challenging toll road up Burke Mountain. The paved surface is approximately 2.3 miles long with 30+ corners.

ALL CARS MUST BE MUFFLED.

HOW MUCH:	Members receive a \$10.00 discount. This includes members of KSCC, SCCNH, or SCCV. SCHEDULE:	<p><u>FRIDAY</u></p> <p>10 AM - Sweep and set up hill – all help is welcome, best way to learn the hill!</p> <p>4 PM or so–dusk: Registration and tech inspection open. Vehicles must be teched in campground, Must be street legal to drive on public road. Rally cars MUST have logbooks with them.</p> <p>6:30 PM: Rookie orientation. If you have not run THIS HILL before, you must attend rookie orientation. Course open to Rally Car teams for pace notes.</p> <p><u>SATURDAY & SUNDAY</u></p> <p><u>Our State permit hours are 8 am to 5:30 pm.</u></p> <p>6:00 AM: Equipment setup and phone testing; close road to non-race traffic. 6:30 AM (approx.): Registration and tech inspection open (Saturday only). Rally cars MUST have logbooks with them. 6:30 AM: Continental Breakfast for all workers 7:30 AM: Phone/equipment setup completed. Group A drivers start lineup for fam run. Combined driver/worker meeting will be called when communications are established to all stations and the course is ready to staff. 7:15 AM: Worker meeting and Assignment (At registration tent) 7:30 AM: Drivers Meeting (At Sugar House) 7:50 AM: Workers report to station (Including Group B driver/workers) 8:00 AM: Begin Group A fam run when “Clear Course” is reported by all stations Sequence will be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Group A fam run and bring down followed by first timed for Group A. Group B fam run and bring down followed by first timed run for Group B. Groups alternate runs for the rest of the day. <p>Noon (approx.): Lunch. Workers will report to Registration Tent 40 MINUTES after signing off station for lunch to receive afternoon assignments. Lunches will be at registration – 1 per driver or worker. 1:00 PM (approx.): Group A and B continue to alternate runs until close of the hill. 5:30 PM (approx.): Close of hill. Worker hydration, lubrication, debriefing and return of radios. Awards will be presented after equipment/wire crews have completed teardown on Sunday.</p> </p>
