**Mt. Philo Hillclimb Special Requirements**

To ensure that we are able to continue to hold events at Mt. Philo we need to make sure to follow our own safety rules and regulations, along with those that the State imposes. Please read, understand and follow the below rules for the Mt. Philo hillclimb. If you have any questions, comments or suggestions, please contact the co-chairs. We are all in this together.

- The direction of traffic will change on the hill starting at noon on Friday. This is to accommodate large vehicles to the top of the hill. This will remain in effect until the drivers' meeting on Saturday morning. After the drivers meeting on Saturday the traffic direction on the hill will revert back to normal for the rest of the weekend. Signs will be posted at the top and bottom.
- **No parking on the grass on the hill.**
- No parking or camping on the lookout (next to the lodge)
- Camping (tent/lentos) reservations go through the SCCV and will follow the state site requirements. This means that there are 11 sites that fit 6 people at each site and two vehicles (for most). There are ten (10) enclosed campers allowed in the top parking lot. You can reserve your lean-to/campsite/camper by e-mailing Steve at SCCVermont@aol.com or by calling 802-777-1000. This is on a first come first served bases. RV/Campers will pay the normal tent fee as you have done in the past and must be paid upon arrival either via cash or check made out to the SCCV.
- All tow vehicles, trailers and non-race vehicles will need to be parked at the bottom of the hill in the parking lot. You can unload your car at the bottom and leave your trailer/truck there. If you need to bring stuff to your campsite, you can still leave your trailer at the bottom. There really isn't room at the top for people to unload their cars. Leave the very end of the lot open for turning around. **Do not park in the grass outside of the parking area.**
- You may only work on your car in the top parking on the paved areas and must take proactive and reactive steps to ensure that oil is cleaned up.
- **Don't do anything stupid. You will be told to leave.**
- Keep the park clean and respect the area. **Do not break branches to get a good video/camera spot.**
- **GATE:** Someone will man the gate at the bottom of the hill until 7:30 PM on Friday. After this time you will have to locate the 'gate keeper' (Mt. Philo Ranger or designated SCCV person). Call me if you need it. **Do NOT circumvent (or disassemble the gate)...** there is no reason for this since we have the combination. Do NOT give the combination to someone not directly involved with the event. Worker cars do NOT need the combination. Call the co-chairs at anytime to get the combination.
- **TARPS MUST BE UNDER ALL VEHICLES AT THE TOP OF THE HILL.**

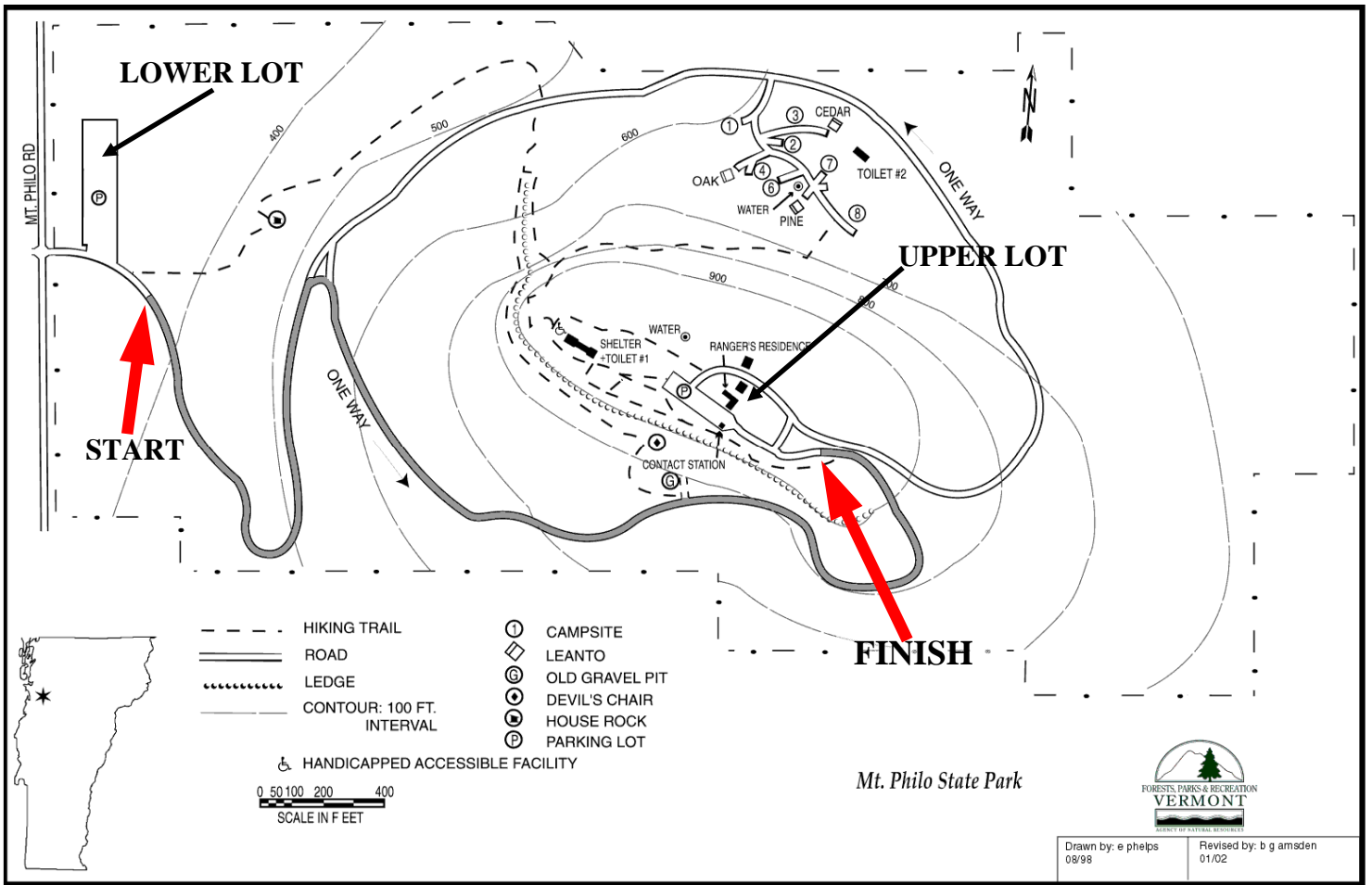
