

NEHA 2009 Rule Changes

General Regulation Changes 2009

Workers of age 16 can now submit rule changes and vote in the annual rules meeting.

Classification Changes 2009

In SP plastic side and rear windows will no longer invoke the excessive lightening penalty if 30 lbs. of compensating weight is added to the car.

A piggyback computer that can modify the mass air flow or MAP sensor is now illegal.

Some classes in U and SP are now limited to two wheel drive cars. This restructured the classes significantly. The intent was to allow the top two classes in U and S to each be split into two classes. One class only allows 2WD vehicles. The new classes are as follows.
